In his presentation, **Shri Md Sadiq**, **CSIR-CLRI Shoe Design & Development Centre** began with a short three minutes clipping from 'TAJ MODEUROP' that provided insights into the 'colour selection' process for the MODEUROP Spring Summer 2015 season and later moved on to present the Colour Groups for the Spring Summer 2015 season in detail. This was done to enable the Members of the Indian Leather Fraternity to quickly recapitulate their collections for the 'Spring Summer 2015 season' as they gear-up for showcasing at the forthcoming Le Cuir A Paris, LINEAPELLE and APLF Fairs in Paris, Bologna and Hong Kong respectively during Feb/ March 2014.

In his presentation on the Colours for Autumn Winter 15/16 season; he highlighted the colour groups for Autumn Winter 15/16 season and said that for Autumn Winter 15/16 season the Colours are either intensely or discreetly coloured, depending on our mood and personal sense of style, as indicated by Promostyl, France.:

Luminous Minerals Felts Inks Azures Emeralds and Turquoises Khakis Yellows and Ochres Terracottas Red-based He then traced the 'Evolution of Colours' through three Winter seasons: Autumn Winter 13/14, 14/15 and 15/16 seasons in the following groups:

- Whites and Flawless Gold
- Felted Tinted Greys
- Terracotta Gradients
- Massive, Tactile Browns
- Atmospheric Blues
- Greens: Duality
- Golden Yellow & Orange
- Deep and Ruby Reds

KEY COLOURS:

CHIC COCOA: A deep and elegant cocoa / ebony brown enhancing noble materials and impeccable detailing: men's suiting, leather and wood. A full and consistent hue to treat either lustrous and waxed or ultra-matte - for designs that are simultaneously structured and supple.

FLESHY OCHRE: Four plush tones reminiscent of skin, earth and wood for minimalist - yet sensual - objects or accessories. A subtle gradient needs no artifice as it reveals and glorifies curves and suppleness.

FOAMY Colorblock: A smart foursome - turquoise / pink / russet / plum - come together for childish color blocks and sweet chubby shapes. Energetic harmonies, foamy textures, play-dough touches and cut-out stickers... all the essentials for a playful, graphic winter story.

BIG SIGNAL: An efficient, bold harmony with a simple association of warm yellow and cold, signal green to combine with Boiler blue and Chipboard beige. Frank, no-frills tones that are easy to coordinate for ultra-desirable pragmatic chic looks

<u>Texture Trends in Four Colour Groups:</u>

A practical and graphical colour story, BLOCK: An urban, industrial and masculine atmosphere, an inventory of rugged, solid and hard-wearing textures.

A COMFORTING RANGE, TENDERNESS: Soothing inspirations and textures - for super-soft "well-being" styles.

A PRECIOUS RANGE: A range that is both a showcase and a treasure associates patina tones and luminous marble and flawless gold.

A FESTIVE RANGE that opens with almost white Kaolin. A sort of imaginary lexicon drawing on magic and the collective subconscious - in all fantasy.
